CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

4H Quality Classes*

4H Quality Classes are for Nezperce County enrolled exhibitors only. Goats conformation and quality are judged in this class. Regardless of what type of 4H project you are doing with your goat (ie, pet, pack, dairy or breeding) in **quality classes** your goat is being judged on its quality as held to its breed standard. You are divided by what type of goat you have (i.e. dairy type or meat type) and then by age of the goat or by whether or not the goat currently has a udder or not. There is no entry fee for this class.

Examples of Dairy Type - Alpine, Lamancha, Nubian, Nigerian, Oberhasli, Toggenburg, Saanen, Sable

Examples of Meat Type - Boer, Kiko, Spanish, Savanna

In the case of dairy and meat goat crosses you should enter the division type that your goat most closely resembles.

4H Showmanship Classes**

4H Showmanship classes are for Nezperce County 4H enrolled exhibitors only. Exhibitors in this class are judged on his or her skills as a showman. Judging is not about the quality of the animal the exhibitor is showing but the conditioning, cleanliness and presentation of the animal and the exhibitor.. There is no entry fee for this class.

Open Youth Showmanship Classes***

Open Youth Showmanship (Open to All Youth 18 Years and Under). Exhibitors in this class are judged on his or her skills as a showman. Judging is not about the quality of the animal the exhibitor is showing but the conditioning, cleanliness and presentation of the animal and the exhibitor. 4H Exhibitors may enter these classes with entry fee.

Open Nervous Newbie Showmanship Classes****

This class is for anyone who has not shown a goat before in any ADGA or 4H Competition. We know how nerve wracking a show can be...this class is for you! If you are a spectator (do not have a goat) and would like to try this just say the word. We have goats you can use! Class is not based on goat quality but on learning showmanship skills for the first time.
