**NO LATE CHECK INS**

1. Show will start promptly at 4 PM with Open Showmanship, then Newbie and then 4H Classes.
2. There is no entry fee for 4H exhibitors.
3. Entries must be postmarked by August 20, 2020. Entries postmarked after August 20, 2020 will be considered late and a late fee of \$10.00 per entry will apply. No entry will be considered complete unless accompanied by the appropriate entry fees.
4. The base date for determining goat's age is the age your goat will be on August 28, 2020.
5. Entries can be non-registered, AGS Purebreds, Canadian Goat Society, or ADGA Purebreds, or Americans. Please include a copy of registration papers if registered. 4H entries need a copy of 4H Goat Identification Form turned in with entry. (See link on website for that form)
6. Health requirements: All animals must be free of all communicable diseases and active abscesses. The Show Chairperson reserves the right to ask for the removal of any animals exhibiting signs of illness, disease or infection. In case of dispute a veterinarian may be called at the exhibitor's expense.
7. Identification Requirement: CGS, AGS and ADGA tattoos are acceptable forms of scrapies identification.
8. Over-uddered does will be discriminated against.
9. You may show from your trailer or bring pens to set up or rent a stall for \$8.
10. 4H Exhibitors may cross enter if they meet requirements but only Nezperce County enrolled exhibitors can enter 4H classes.
11. The show is being held at the Nezperce County Fair Grounds in Lewiston, Idaho. You may come and park overnight in the designated area where RV parking and camping are allowed. (Map is provided on the show website.) RV camping with or without electrical hook ups are available. ALL GOATS KEPT IN TRAILERS MUST CLEAN UP THEIR AREA ENTIRELY OF HAY, SHAVINGS OR STRAW. (See entry for fees)
12. Dogs are not allowed in the show area or barn unless they are service dogs. ALL dogs must be on a leash. Disruptive or barking dogs must be removed.
